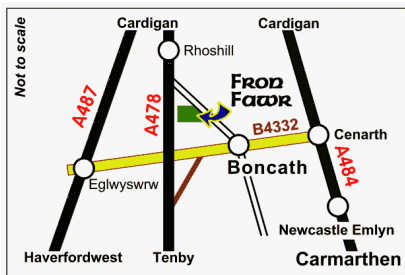

They are loved by children but are extremely sturdy and quite suitable for 'young at heart' adults.

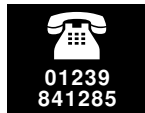

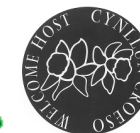

HOW TO BOOK

To book a cottage first check availability on Fron Fawr's website or phone **01239 841285** to check availability for the cottage most suited to meet your needs.

Then within 7 days of having made a booking complete the Booking Form overleaf and return it along with the appropriate payment.

BOOKING DATES between April and October are for a minimum of one week; Friday or Saturday arrivals subject to availability. All the cottages are available throughout the year and between September and March may be booked for Weekend or Midweek Breaks (minimum 3 nights) *Christmas and New Year Weeks' arrival and departure days are subject to availability; minimum 7 nights.*

LINEN and TOWELS will be waiting for your arrival. All your beds will be made up and Bathroom Towels and Tea Towels ready for use. Beach Towels and baby cot linen are not provided.

PETS are accepted but only by prior arrangement and on the condition that they are not allowed onto any furniture, into any bedroom and while out of your cottage and at Fron Fawr they must be kept on a lead so as to avoid any problems with animals grazing on the land. The charge per pet per week is: £15.00.
